0	Internal Tracking: RW staff are working on organizing data to provide appropriate support. This includes checking indicators during report card distribution, identifying IPP supports or not, or additional engagement required.	
0	Formative Processes - the focus group of teachers supporting numeracy and literacy meet regularly to solve any challenges.	
0	Perception Data- principal advisory group continues to provide requests from students. This is a great opportunity to learn about what's important to the students.	
0	RW is collaborating with other middle schools to think about ideas to support students' growth and understanding, especially as it pertains to applying mathematical and literacy skills to everyday life.	
0	Truth and Reconciliation: Elder Shirly will attend RW Wednesday Feb 19, Thursday Feb 20 to teach students about indigenous ways of learning. This was supported by students.	
0	School budget: RW received \$2,112,471.00 for 2024/2025 school year. This budget covers everything required to provide quality education and the school development plan.	
0	School trips: we have an array of field trips, in-school activities, residencies and sports opportunities this school term to suit the varying interests of our students.
